# **Application Fee**

The application fee for the Mannheim Master in Management Analytics & Al (Part-Time) is €99 and must be paid when submitting the application package.

Please note that your application will only be processed once the application fee has been received.

#### **Tuition**

The current tuition fee is €29,000 (regular fee €32,000). We offer three early-bird discounts for the Mannheim Master in Management Analytics & Al (Part-Time)

in connection with four admission rounds for the intake 2024. The tuition fee includes courses and course materials at MBS. It does not include costs for some certificates, for example Scrum.

## **Payment Terms and Options (Admission Round 1)**

We offer two payment options.

Option 1: In two installments. The first installment of €3,000 is due two weeks after receiving the admissions contract, at the latest by May 1, 2024. The second installment of €23,000 is due by June 1, 2024. If you choose this option, a reduction of €500 is included.

Option 2: In four installments. The first installment of €3,000 is due two weeks after receiving the admissions contract, at the latest by May 1, 2024. Further installments: €8,000 due by July 1, 2024; €8,000 due by April 15, 2025; €7,500 due by April 15, 2026.
