Application Fee

The application fee for the Mannheim Master in Management Analytics (Part-Time) is €99 and must be paid when submitting the application package.

Please note that your application will only be processed once the application fee has been received.

Tuition

The regular tuition fee is €29,000. We offer two Early Bird discounts for the Mannheim Master in Management Analytics (Part-Time) in connection with two admission rounds for the intake

2023. The tuition fee includes courses and course materials at MBS. It does not include costs for some certificates, for example Scrum.

Payment Terms and Options (Example Admission Round 1)

We offer two payment options.

Option 1: In two installments. The first installment of €3,000 is due two weeks after receiving the admissions contract, at the latest by February 1, 2023. The second installment of €23,000 is due by March 1, 2023. If you choose this option, a reduction of €500 is included.

Option 2: In four installments. The first installment of €3,000 is due two weeks after receiving the admissions contract, at the latest by February 1, 2023. Further installments: €8,000 due by April 1, 2023; €8,000 due by January 15, 2024; €7,500 due by January 15, 2025.
