Mannheim Master in Sustainability and Impact Management Class of 2024

Application Fee

The application fee for the Mannheim Mannheim Master in Sustainability and Impact Management is EUR 99 and has to be paid when submitting the application documents.

Please note that your application will only be processed once the application fee has been received.

Tuition Fee

The regular tuition fee is €32,000, we offer the Mannheim Master in Sustainability and Impact Management in its second year at the introductory price of €24,000.

The tuition fee includes courses and course materials at MBS.

When you apply by January 31, 2022, you will receive an early bird discount of €1,500. The tuition fee is then €22,500.

Payment Terms and Options

We offer two payment options.

Option 1: In two installments. The first installment of EUR 3,000 is due two weeks after receiving the admissions contract, at the latest by September 1, 2022. The second installment of EUR 20,500 (EUR 19,000 respectively if early bird discount applies) is due by October 1, 2022. If you choose this option, a reduction of EUR 500 is included.

Option 2: In four installments. The first installment of EUR 3,000 is due two weeks after receiving the admissions contract, at the latest by September 1, 2022. Further installments: EUR 7,000 (EUR 5,500 respectively if early bird discount applies) due by January 1, 2023; EUR 7,000 due by June 1, 2023; EUR 7,000 due by February 1, 2024.
